To undertake and promote studies that monitor the changes, especially the degradation and fragmentation, experienced by the principal eco-regions in Paraguay (namely the Atlantic Forest, Cerrado, Grasslands of the Missions region, Pantanal, and Chaco), including both urban and cross-border ecosystems, and within the context of an ecological vision at the landscape scale, thus allowing the implementation of a sustainable management system of those landscapes.</p> <p>4. Public Policies and Advocacy. To undertake policy and advocacy activities to multiply the organizational impact in different places of the country and focused on training replicating agents to promote awareness building in conservation and sustainable development, especially on birds and their habitats.</p> <p>5. People, Communication and Education. To develop mechanisms and technologies for communication and education in order to generate incentives, benefits and active participation of local communities and replicating agents while integrating interests in human development with ecological requirements for birds and biodiversity in general and guaranteeing the ecological integrity of areas important for biodiversity conservation.</p> <p>These five strategic objectives are complemented by two internal cross-cutting objectives:</p> <p>6. Institutional Development. To advance towards the organizational self-sufficiency with the capacity of maintaining and developing its own programs with the national and international recognition, with an adequate infrastructure, a clear institutional policy endorsed by the board and led by the Executive Director, a committed staff in permanent training to add value to the institutional performance.</p> <p>7. Land management. To establish management and operational plans for the reserves operated by Guyra Paraguay in order to secure their conservation in the long run while promoting the participation of local conservation groups in the sites' operations.</p> |
