

World Land Trust Christmas Card Competition

There is no theme, but the winning design will need to be appropriately designed to be reproduced as a WLT Christmas card.

Rules and Conditions of Entry: submission of artwork will be taken as acceptance of these rules.

- > Competition is open for entries from all professional and amateur artists over the age of 16.
- There will be one overall winner for the competition for a printed card and one winner who will have their card reproduced as a featured eCard. WLT will print the overall winning design on a Christmas card and the winner will receive 100 free printed cards. (WLT reserves the right to print runner-up entries and use any submitted designs for eCards.) Runner-up prizes TBC.
- Entry must be a 2 dimensional medium (painting/collage/drawing/printing etc). Entries to be maximum of A3 297mm x 420 mm- size (including mount); smaller is acceptable. (Art with and without mounts accepted.) Entries must be dry when they are submitted.
- Entries must be submitted to the World Land Trust gallery or reception between Monday 16th and Thursday 19th July. Judging will take place the week of 23rd July 2012.
- > Original artwork must be supplied. Work must be that of the artist; an original creation, completed by the entrant.
- Only one entry per person. Copyright for submitted artwork transfers to WLT. The winning entry will be produced as Christmas cards for sale with proceeds going to WLT, all artwork may be reproduced digitally for the purposes of publicity, and some originals may also be hung in the gallery. WLT retains the right to sell artwork on display at a price fixed by the organistion unless artists specifically request return of their art; artists must make a donation to World Land Trust to cover costs of Special Delivery return postage (~£6 within the UK).
- > Judges will be professional artists Bob Linney and Bruce Pearson.
- > The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- > All entries must be labelled, please PRINT the artist's name and picture title on the back of the artwork.
- > Each entry must also be accompanied by a completed entry form.
- > While the gallery will endeavour to treat all work with maximum care, it will not be held responsible for any damage to artwork.
- The names of the winners (with pictures if appropriate) will be published on the WLT website and will be displayed in the WLT gallery.
